Article Spirituality And **Community Life**

"How great is my gratitude. What is he reserving for us in heaven if here below His love dispenses surprises so delightful?" Says St. Therese. The first word that she spoke was 'Heaven' and the last word that she concludes with is also the same, 'I will spend my heaven in doing good on earth'. She was for sure about her space in heaven. She believed this "unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven" Mt 18:3. Heaven was a concern for her. And it must be a topic for our thought too 'how to get in heaven?"

And it was the same that Jesus came with his preaching, "Unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven" Mt 5:20. Jesus said this to his disciples who followed him. The scribes pride themselves on their ability to interpret the law correctly, and the Pharisees pride themselves on keeping the law in all of its detail. They represent the religious establishment in Israel.

Looking at them Jesus says, "Externally you are not disobeying any laws and looks perfect but what is there in your heart". So he said, "you honor me with your lips, but your hearts are far away from me" Mt 15:8. You seek the glory that belongs to God (6:2, 5). You teach human precepts as doctrines (15:9; 23:16-22). You fail to observe the weightier matters of the law (23:23). While you look presentable on the outside, "within you are full of hypocrisy and iniquity" (23:28). Jesus calls them hypocrites on a number of occasions (6:5, 16; 15:7). The greatest of their failures, however, is their spiritual pride.

And sometimes we are tempted to pray, "God, I thank you that I am not like these Pharisees" (Lk 18:11). When that happens, we have adopted their spiritual pride.

It was the spirituality the then religious leaders were following and Jesus was against it. And I feel, it continues even after 2000 years, a spirituality without proper conversion of the

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she lived.

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hearts. Most often our focus is on the external activities. Externally we conduct big celebrations, road shows, rallies, processions, decorations, langar etc. Everyone wants to exhibit before others that they are doing something. And we are satisfied with the sound and setting. But the question is, are all these really helping the faithful to make a 'U' turn in their spiritual life? And we forget, if our internal dispositions do not alter any inner changes within, then the external acts that we do may not bring any long lasting effects and influence on others. Today's church is facing this threat all the more that we are more externally focused but do we realize the decline of spirituality from ourselves and from our faithful? So, spirituality without conversion of hearts is a danger!

The second aspect of the article focuses on the community aspect. As I mentioned above, if our spirituality is not proper, then we can't have a proper community life. Community life doesn't mean that a group of people staying together under the same roof. It is the communion of the hearts. Without communion, we can't have a community and religious life. We may be doing all the community activities together but if there is no communion or unity among you; then it's not community life. God doesn't look at our actions but our attitude; he looks at what is happening inside us. Like Therese, only when we recognize our nothingness, and the providence of God in our lives that we can have communion with others.

"Let us love, since that is what our hearts were made for, without love, deeds, even the most brilliant, count as nothing." Spirituality without conversion and community life without communion is not the mind of the Lord. To enter into heaven or to walk in the path of the Lord, our spirituality and communion must be repaired. May God bless and St. Therese shower her roses upon each one of us that we may be able to live a life that
